	Systematic study or investigation in a particular field, usually for the purpose of learning new facts and making interpretations.
	a subject for a composition or essay
	To briefly state the main points
	A point of view
	To pass off someone else's work or ideas as your own
	A complete listing of source materials
	A sentence made up of more than one independent clause
	The condition of which you can use material that is copyrighted by someone else without paying royalties.
	When the character is speaking and then there is some action and then the character continues to speak
	Documentation at the bottom of the page referring to a part of the text
	A sentence made up an independent clause and a dependent clause
	To reword; restate the meaning of a word or passage
	The reason for writing
	A firsthand or eyewitness account of an event (ex: autobiography)
	Charts, graphs, photos, captions, diagrams, etc.
	An independent clause
	The person or people reading an essay or paper
	To determine the accuracy of something by checking with various sources
	A document that describes and event, person, place or thing (ex: biography)
	An explanation added to the end of an article, chapter, etc.
	A sentence with two or more independent clauses and dependent clauses
	The Modern Language Association rules for citation
	A citation placed as close as possible without interrupting the sentence
	Citation place immediately after a quote or paraphrase
